# Notes:

- (1) The Range will now be open from sun up to sun down, 7 days a week
- (2) Any date that is not specifically shown above are Open Range days.
- (3) Competitors do not need to pay the "Money Match" fee if they don't want to compete for money
- (4) Normal Club match fees (including Money Matches) for members continue to be \$5.00/yardage, non-members \$10.00/yardage. This does not include Registered matches.
- (5) Registered Match Fee will be \$50.00 per day,

## GENERAL MATCH RULES - 2025 SEASON

- 1. All shooters 18 years old and younger will shoot for free. This also pertains to non-members. Nonmembers over 18 shall pay \$10 per match.
- 2. Prior to each match there will be a 5-minute Safety Meeting led by the designated Range Officer. Attendance at this meeting for all match shooters is mandatory. The purpose of these meetings is to ensure full understanding of the new Match Day safety procedures. Shooters that arrive late to the day's match and do not attend this meeting cannot shoot the first target until they review the Match Day safety procedures. The late shooter may then elect to start shooting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> target (Group) or sets of targets (Ground Hog), whichever is applicable to the match of the day.
- 3. Note that the range will be open after matches. 5:30 PM for Ground Hog match days. Depending on the start time of the Group matches the OPEN RANGE time will be either 1:30 PM or 2:30 PM. Note the schedule.

### **GROUP MATCH RULES - 2025 SEASON**

- 1. Heavy Varmint Rules: Total gun weight not to exceed 13.5 lbs. with sights. Any scope power and any caliber is OK. There will be time to reload between targets. Heavy Varmint Class Shooters fire from the bench at 100&200 yards on standard benchrest targets utilizing a sighter bull and a 5 shot group bull.
- 2. You must fire at least 5 regular distance matches and 3 alternate distance matches in Heavy Varmint to qualify for season average and/or aggregate trophies. (HV: 5 matches at 200 yds. and 3 at 100 yds.) Awards will be given for smallest group at both 100 and 200 Yards, as well as for best single agg. at 100 and 200 yards. These last awards will be given out regardless of the number of matches shot.

### GROUNDHOG MATCH RULES: 2025 SEASON

**GROUNDHOG RULES:** ALL TARGETS SHOT FOR SCORE, 100YD (5) record bulls one sighter bull, 200yd (5) record bull for 5 shot and (1) sighter bull. No flags and No Mirage boards. All classes below will shoot together. Targets will be the same groundhog targets as last year unless specified differently for class. All guns shall comply with range rules. Groundhog Captains (referees) will determine what class a particular rifle fits. When in doubt it goes to Outlaw Class.

**FACTORY CLASS:** Any production rifle in its original stock with original barrel and action. Any caliber within range rules is legal. Any power scope or iron sights are legal. No flat bottom benchrest stocks are allowed. Aftermarket triggers may be installed including Jewel, Kelbly, or Rifle Basics. Guns that do not qualify in this class are 40X, Cooper, Kimber and other limited production, semi-custom guns.

**CUSTOM CLASS:** This class includes any rifle, any action, any caliber (within range rules), any trigger, and any sight. No flat bottom benchrest stocks are allowed. AR-15/10 semi-auto platform rifles shall be required to shoot in this class for competition in the groundhog class. All semi/auto in AR-15/10 shall meet the following: A sled type single shot magazine is required. An attached empty shell catching net must be attached to the rifle. During range safe conditions, magazines must be removed, and bolts locked back with an "Empty chamber Indicator" (ECI) must be installed. The only accepted end of barrel attachment shall be a legal noise suppressor. All released pressure shall be directed towards targets. Threaded barrels shall not have attached Flash suppressors or

stabilizers.

**CAST BULLET CLASS:** Open to all styles and configurations- single shot, bolt action, lever action. Only requirement is that cast bullets must be used. No restrictions on stocks or sights. Scoped rifles will use the standard targets, open sights will use the 200-yard groundhog target at 100 yards and at 200 yard the standard 200-yard (6) bull score target.

**OUTLAW CLASS:** This class has replaced the vintage class. This class accepts all rifles including all bench guns, F class guns, long range bolt "Precision Rifle Series" (PRS) guns etc. They will be fired single shot like all other classes. no weight restrictions. All AR-15/10 platform auto rifles shall meet requirements detailed in the Custom Class. All calibers except 50 cal. BMG. This is a catch all class so everyone can participate. When questions arise, the captains can put the participant in the Outlaw Class.

TACK DRIVER 300 yd. CLASS: This year the 300 yd. Tack Driver Class will only take place in Groundhog matches. This class again will only shoot during the 200 yd. matches. Any rifle meeting range rules can be used in this class. AR-15/10 platforms shall meet prior requirements. There will be a maximum of 6 shooters shooting at 6 targets at a time. Benches 1 through 6 shall be reserved for shooters and the prone mound location. Any position may be used from the mound location; bipods, shooting sticks etc. may be used. No portable seat rest at the mound. Benches 1 thru 6 must be shot as benchrest positions with appropriate rest etc. Once the maximum of 6 shooter positions are filled (combined bench and mound) others may shoot in the remaining classes from open benches 7 thru 20. 6 bull score targets will be used for these matches. Bench or mound positions shall be first come first shoot basis. Mound shooters must align the end of muzzles as close as possible to one another and bench shooters. Mound shooters are not to shoot past any body part of the person next to them. Shooters of this class will be required to post and pull 300 yd. targets. Scoring will be done by shooters of this class. Scoring results shall be given to the range match recorder. The scores will be added to the daily match score sheet. Results from this class will not be credited to the 200 yd. scores or qualify for awards. Target cameras or spotting scopes are permitted to be used for this class. Wind flags are not permitted to be used during any match times. Shooters wanting to practice at the benches and mound during 100 yd. matches may do so. Practice shooters must follow range times and match rules.

**Awards:** There will be 7 matches at 100 yards and 7 matches at 200 yards. Scoring will be the best 3 out of 7 for the 100 and 3 out of 7 for the 200 yards added together. There will be 1,2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards for Custom, Factory and Cast classes only. Positions will be awarded based on combined aggregates for the year.
